

YMCA Community Campaign Fundraiser for Youth Scholarships

Horace Mann 7th grade students will be participating in the YMCA Community Partnership Campaign. All funds raised will be rewarded back to Horace Mann students for YMCA program scholarships.

The Community Partnership Campaign is an annual event that solicits money to help low-income children experience the YMCA through memberships and/or participation in a sport or camping program.
