- ⇒ No in-school or out of school suspensions
- \Rightarrow No cutting classes (Ex: absent from class 10 minutes or more)
- \Rightarrow No truancy court (determined by HM administration)
- \Rightarrow No unexcused absences (periods 1-10)
- ⇒ Student must attend school on the day of dance
- \Rightarrow 3 Minor BTFs = no dance
- \Rightarrow 1 Major BTF = no dance

Admission

- ⇒ Dance time 7:00 pm-9:00 pm
- ⇒ Dance held in HM cafetorium
- ⇒ Coats stored in Large Group Room
- \Rightarrow Late arrivals after 7:10pm will not be admitted to the dance
- \Rightarrow Cost \$3
- ⇒ MUST bring Horace Mann ID
- ⇒ MUST follow the school's dress code
- \Rightarrow MUST have a ride home by 9:15 p.m.

Health Services

IMPORTANT: If your child is feeling ill during the school day,

please have them report to the health office.

We will contact you to make arrangements for them to be picked up or sent home.



Information regarding your child and illness.

Please follow these guidelines from the Wausau School District for illness:

Masks are optional within the Wausau School District, so if you prefer to send your child to school with a mask, you are more than welcome to do that.

Here's what else you need to know:

- If your child is sick (COVID-19 or something else), keep them home.
- If your child is showing COVID-19 symptoms, we recommend they get tested.


 We accept PCR, Rapid Antigen, and home tests.
- If the test comes back negative, they can return to school when they are fever free for 24 hours without medication and their symptoms are improving.
- If they test positive, we recommend that they quarantine for 5 days from their symptom onset. So what does that look like? The first day of their symptoms is considered DAY 0. Once 5 days have passed, they are then cleared to return to school on DAY 6. When they return, we recommend they wear a mask until DAY 10.

Reminder: All medication, prescription or over the counter, (i.e., ibuprofen, Tylenol, Tums, cold medication) must be kept in the health office during the school day. Students may carry emergency medication, inhalers and diabetic supplies. They also may carry cough drops, if needed.


You can update your personal information all year through your parent portal.

Wisconsin parents and caregivers,

The Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of School Safety (OSS) is thrilled to announce the launch of the SPEAK UP, SPEAK OUT Resource Center (SUSO). SUSO is a comprehensive, one-stop place to turn to with your concerns regarding school safety. A facet of the Resource Center that we are particularly pleased to share with Wisconsin students and parents is the threat reporting system.

The SUSO threat reporting system is available 24/7 and is free to all.

Students, parents, school staff and community members can submit a school safety concern, beginning in early September, by downloading the SUSO app (Android and iOS), visiting speakup.widoj.gov or by calling 1-800-MY-SUSO-1. Resource Center staff work around-the-clock to respond to reports and to deploy a response locally by communicating directly with school administrators, law enforcement and counselors.

Nationwide, more than half of public middle and high schools now operate a tip line.

Threat reporting systems - or tip lines - are recommended for use by the United States Secret Service when developing comprehensive school violence prevention plans. Tip lines are used to identify threats to schools, and other daily safety concerns students encounter, such as bullying, drug use, suicidal thoughts and more.

Of school administrators who participated in a recent survey surrounding the use of school tip lines, 77% believed that their tip line made them more aware of safety issues at their school, 73% reported that their tip line had prevented incidents of self-harm or suicide, and more than half believed their tip line had prevented violent incidents.¹

It's time to break the code of silence.

Who knows more about what's going on, in or out of school, than students themselves? Individually and collectively, they play an essential role in keeping Wisconsin schools safe. It's crucial for students to understand that there's a clear difference between tattling or "snitching" and disclosing concerning information to a trusted adult to keep themselves and their classmates safe. The SUSO threat reporting system aims to empower students to share their concerns safely and confidentially without fear of retaliation. We encourage you to talk to your students about the importance of letting a trusted adult know about their safety concerns.


